## THE SASKATCHEWAN ASSOCIATION OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS ACADEMIC AWARD

This annual award is provided to assist Saskatchewan students registered in an accredited or recognized bachelor or master of landscape architecture program anywhere in the world. The award amount for the 2019 - 2020 school year will be \$1500.00 (one thousand five hundred) dollars. The award can be held for **one year**. If no applications are received it may be extended to two years as funds allow.

The award will be presented on the basis of:

1. Academic standing
2. Qualities of character, leadership skills and participation in student and community activities
3. Level of experience in the field
4. Level of education attained
