

# NOTICE OF AWARD

## SASKATCHEWAN ASSOCIATION OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS ACADEMIC AWARD

Do you have a grade 12 high school diploma from Saskatchewan? If so, you may be eligible for this award even if you no longer live in Saskatchewan and no longer have a Saskatchewan health card. This annual award is provided to assist Saskatchewan students registered in an accredited or recognized bachelor or Master of Landscape Architecture program anywhere in the world. The award amount for the 2022- 2023 school year will be \$1500.00 (one thousand five hundred) dollars. The award can be held for **one year**. If no applications are received it may be extended to two years as funds allow.

To qualify, the student must be a resident of Saskatchewan\* and must be registered in an accredited program as determined by the CSLA. At this time candidacy programs can not apply. <http://www.csla-aapc.ca/career-resources/accredited-university-programs>

The award will be presented on the basis of:

1. Academic standing
2. Qualities of character, leadership skills and participation in student and community activities
3. Level of experience in the field
4. Level of education attained

\*Saskatchewan residency is determined by a signed declaration of a valid Saskatchewan health card as noted on our application form. If the student gave up Saskatchewan residency due to summer employment, a signed declaration of an expired health card, along with proof of a Saskatchewan high school diploma is required.

\*\* In 2023 the award deadline will change to September 30<sup>th</sup> to align with LACF preferences.
